## **ANTX RELEASES PUMP STATION MONITOR**

**DiaLog Scout provides pump run times, cycles,  
daily flow total direct to fax and the internet**

**AUSTIN, TEXAS...** Antx, a leading provider of real-time monitoring, control and alarm notification systems for companies with remote assets that require maintenance, monitoring and control, has released new capabilities in the DiaLog Scout. The new features provide calculations for pump stations that can be reported via daily faxes and or direct to the internet.

Included are computations of pump run times, cycles and total flow calculations, all of which are recorded as daily totals to the internal data log which can be locally viewed via the display or remotely printed via modem connection. Additionally, the data can be automatically reported to the internet and made available through Antx' DiaLog Online service.

Any digital input channel can be configured to compute the run times and cycles and any analog channel can be configured to compute the totalized flow.

According to Stephen Allen, CEO of Antx, "This additional capability was developed to save significant amounts of operator's time in checking pump stations. Now users can review on a daily basis how much water has flowed into a distribution system, how fast wells are recovering or how lift station pumps are being utilized, all without any need to visit the remote site."

The updated version started shipping in April of 2004.
